I have been favored with your letter of yesterday transmitting to me therewith by order of the Minister of Finance 300 Dollars which His Excellency the Dictator of Peru has been pleased to command should be given to some of my men who have been usefully employed in constructing a convenient landing place at Chorrillos.

I have the honor to desire you will request the Minister of Finance to return my best thanks to His Excellency the Libertador for his liberal gift, which I accept with pleasure on the part of my men, as a pleasing proof of the desire of His Excellency to give every encouragement to industry & the improvement of facilities of commerce, which I trust have been essentially benefited in this instance.
